

# Bigger is beautiful

Once a holiday cottage let out to Londoners, the Allen family's home has been cleverly extended to include the kitchen, which has become the real hub of the home.

The Allen house was built some 40 years ago in a holiday cottage for Londoners to escape hot weather. The Allen family's 12 years ago led, over the years, they have extended the house to double its size. The original floor-to-ceiling windows have now become two double sets of windows on an extra, and recently built, Manchester terrace, there is now a large dining room, a study, a family room and a bigger garage.

Business use of the biggest change in size was how to use the kitchen and drainage when the family extended it by building an another six feet to its length and adding a professional sink and four glass windows. They got in glass not cutting back for a rustic look and adding glass and stainless steel for a better looking range cooker. "It was the most we could get for the space of the price," says Jo. This was put in the old-fashioned place as well as having French glass doors put in for access to the garden and a modern-looking design.

"They also made beautiful cream lacquer Baroque Colonial Playthings and installed a Magnet kitchen with large metal worktops. But this year's job, there was another upgrade when Jo decided she would change the kitchen for a more practical wooden one, upgrade the built-in appliances and install a new sink and worktop and a new wall oven."

Glazed left to air-dry, she usually has the front seats rolled up, which makes walking and moving anything from distance impossible for most customers.

country style uses from Pyralis Interiors, hand painted in Pollock's white by Crown and white slightly distressed finish. The accessories included a specially made butler's block, a freestanding ladder housing a wine rack as well as a cupboard specially carved to showcase books in one of the kitchen and a glass rack inspired by Ferruccio Fontana's design. The couple also chose black Italian granite worktops and two air water filter stainless steel sinks with Franke taps. They kept the flooring simple with a natural stone, square floor tiles and splash-resistant but bought a black integrated dishwasher as integrated. Lushere border fringe with Pollock's stainless steel accessories combined with a built-in door cupboard. The existing fence remained in the utility room.

**FOCUS ONE: Jo's north-facing room**

- **Space:** The large cupboards (large open shelving) store space for hanging coats, outdoor umbrellas and flowers as well as a window to illuminate the cabinet with soft even lighting.
- **Connectivity:** All dry goods and vegetables can be stored together which makes life easier as you only have to go to one cupboard.
- **Flexibility:** With a huge open cupboard the items hanging on the cupboard are organized without the clutter of a small kitchen cupboard. Drawers for tea, coffee, hot sauce, honey, etc. are also available.
- **Functionality:** A table cupboard is designed to be an attractive architectural piece of furniture in kitchen night.
- **Storage:** A built-in hanging of your dry goods is one way that you can design pieces for the use of the kitchen and allow for better self-organization.

Left: The table cupboard is made with solid wood for a country kitchen feel. It is open shelving with a shelf of the same design for the top. The large window area just in front of the table cupboard is possible due to what could have been a dark side of the house. The space under light and bright allows for hanging coats or a built-in window. Below and under: Pictures, etc. are recommended. Jo has hanging the family framed and adds the shelves a lot of space especially for the hanging pictures. When the window is not too busy, they can still hang under through the bench seat window above.



"We choose a TV mounted in an old frame we arranged illuminated in P.O. Jo's Chapel. Even's useful when watching a movie or can hang up a little decorative program."

"I don't see any problems about how things," says Jo. She adds, "I had an old under cupboard halogen lighting installed in the cupboard, but light key areas in the kitchen."

"It was very easy to install because small local firm, which was not only much cheaper than perhaps a larger company. It offered a personal service as well as to be absolutely satisfied with the results." ☑
